



INTERVIEW AND INTERROGATION FDLE #047 – 40 HOURS

Program Description:

This course will equip criminal justice officers with the skills and techniques necessary for conducting effective interviews during investigations. The officer will learn applicable statutes and current case law affecting interviews and interrogations, including recent laws affecting Miranda issues. The officer will learn ways to detect deception in interviews and written statements. Officers will participate in scenarios to practice the skills they have learned. Officers who complete the Criminal Law course may be eligible for salary incentive payments or may apply this course toward satisfying their mandatory retraining requirements, per Florida Statutes. This course may be used for mandatory retraining or salary incentive credit.
