Program Description:

This course is designed to introduce the student to the roles, responsibilities, skills, knowledge, and expectations of a successful instructor and to enhance the student's facilitation and instructional abilities. This specialized instructor course provides the required training an officer must have to apply for a General Instructor Certification. Due to the competency nature of this course, each student will be required to demonstrate basic competency as an instructor and complete a final presentation. Students must achieve a passing score of at least 85% on the written end-of-course examination.

This course may be used for mandatory retraining or salary incentive credit.
