Program Description:

The FTO course is designed to introduce many aspects of field training and evaluation programs modeled after the San Jose Police Department in California to the criminal justice officer. The program was established in the 1970s and is widely emulated in many Florida Criminal Justice agencies. Officers who successfully complete this course may be eligible for salary incentive payments or may apply this course toward satisfying their mandatory retraining requirements, per Florida Statutes.
