



INTERVIEW AND INTERROGATION **FDLE #047 – 40 HOURS**

Program Description:

This course will provide criminal justice officers with the skills and techniques for conducting effective interviews during an investigation. The officer will learn applicable statutes and current case law affecting interviews and interrogations, including recent laws affecting Miranda issues. The officer will learn ways to detect deception in interviews and written statements. Officers will participate in scenarios to practice the learned skills. Officers who complete the Criminal Law course may be eligible for salary incentive payments or may apply this course toward satisfying their mandatory retraining requirements, per Florida Statutes. This course may be used for mandatory retraining or salary incentive credit.
