

# SPEED MEASUREMENT

## FDLE #1158 – 40 HOURS DAY TIME

### Program Description:

The course satisfies Florida statute 943.14 and is designed to improve the effectiveness of speed enforcement through the proper and effective use of RADAR speed measurement instruments. Theory and application are presented, followed by the usage of the equipment to measure vehicle speed. At the end of this program, students will understand the relationship between speed offenses, motor vehicle crashes, and injuries. The course will cover the development, fundamental concepts, and principles of police traffic radar and laser. The course will also give students an understanding of tests used to determine that police traffic radar and laser devices function properly, the proper operation of traffic radar and laser devices, and the potential for error. At least 12 hours of hands-on practical exercises will be performed as part of the course.

Officers who complete this course may be eligible for a salary incentive payment or apply this course toward satisfying their mandatory retraining requirements, per Florida Statutes.
