DUAL ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES:

Students must:

- 1. Use this form to withdraw from classes. The instructor must provide the last date of attendance prior to processing. If the instructor does not sign the form, an email from the instructor with last date of attendance must be attached.
- 2. Obtain the signature of the high school guidance counselor (required) before this form will be processed.
- 3. For homeschool students, the parent signature as guidance counselor is required.

Failure to follow these procedures may result in the cancellation of your request.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

Students must maintain the required Florida Gateway College GPA and the required unweighted high school GPA to continue enrolling in the Dual Enrollment classes. If the GPA falls below the specific level, the student will no longer be able to participate in the program.

Any student earning a W in a course will either need to sit out the next term and be required to repeat the course the next eligible term along with any other program related coursework or repeat the withdrawn course and only the withdrawn course the next term. If the student receives a second W in any course, Dual Enrollment eligibility will end. If a student makes two W grades in one term in different courses, eligibility for Dual Enrollment will end.
