

GUIDED PATHWAY: Facial Specialty COSMETOLOGY PROGRAMS

The Facial Specialty Certificate program teaches facial practices which prepare students to gain employment as Florida licensed Facial Specialist. This program is a one-semester program offered every fall and spring semester. Students will perform basic skin care services including skin analysis, facials, makeup application and superfluous hair removal.

The Facial Specialty Certificate is designed to provide the training required in order to acquire skills and knowledge necessary to become a licensed Facial Specialist. This includes passing the exit exam and receiving the completing hours. The program prepares students to apply for licensure and meet industry standards to help secure employment opportunities.
