## PRE-ENROLLMENT ACTION ITEMS

1. Apply for Admission: Click the following link to apply.

- 2. Apply for financial aid. Apply online at https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa
- Take required proof of residency (see page four of application) to admissions in building 15 on the main FGC campus. Or email documents to: enrollment.services@fqc.edu
- 4. Have official high school and all college transcripts sent to the FGC admissions office.

Bring the following items with you to your advising appointment with the EMS Coordinator:

- Completed program-specific application
- Resume
- Cover Letter
- Driver's License
- Proof of health insurance coverage
- Proof of immunizations

AFTER your advising appointment, complete the following as directed by the EMS Coordinator:

- Pass the required background check and drug screen from the contracted provider.
- Order Uniforms.
- Register and pay for the courses in the FGC registrar's office.
- Attend a program orientation.
- Obtain the books and other necessary supplies prior to the first day of class.
